

# 5 Checklist points for your oil tank.

The summer period is a great time to pay a little attention to your oil tank. At this time of year the oil level is usually lower meaning any maintenance work is done quickly and easily. Below are 5 tips to help.....

Look for any signs of spillage, dead vegetation or a strong smell of fuel may indicate a leak

Any tank installation or repositioning work needs to be carried out by an OFTEC registered engineer. Visit [www.oftec.org.uk](http://www.oftec.org.uk) to find your nearest engineer.

Ensure the cap fits securely and that the guage is kept clean to ensure the level is displayed accurately. We can also provide a FREE tank sticker to display the type of fuel inside.

Inspect the overall surface of the tank, especially the seams or welds for any signs of cracking or damage

Keep your tank clear of vegetation especially around the filler and vent caps, an overgrown tank will hide any possible damage and hinder delivery.
